PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the City of Falls Church is known for the beauty of its trees and plantings; and

WHEREAS, trees release oxygen into our atmosphere while reducing carbon dioxide, provide habitat for wildlife, reduce the erosion of soil by the wind and water, filter pollutants before they reach our waterways and reduce heating and cooling cost by moderating temperatures; and

WHEREAS, the City of Falls Church has been designated as a “Tree City, USA” by the National Arbor Day Foundation for 37 consecutive years; and

WHEREAS, in 1892, the first observance of Arbor Day in the Commonwealth of Virginia took place in Falls Church at the old Jefferson School, as organized by the Village Improvement Society (predecessor of the present Village Preservation and Improvement Society); and

WHEREAS, each April since 1974 Falls Church has held a city-wide celebration of Arbor Day, during which elementary school children take part in the planting of trees on school grounds, and citizens plant trees and otherwise join the observance, including an afternoon program at Frady Park; and

WHEREAS, the American holly (*Ilex opaca*) has been selected as the 2015 “Tree of the Year” by the Falls Church Tree Commission and the Department of Public Works Urban Forestry Division,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, P. David Tarter, Mayor of the City of Falls Church, Virginia, in recognition of the economic, social and environmental benefits that healthy trees provide to our community, do hereby proclaim April 18, 2015 as

ARBOR DAY

in the City of Falls Church and urge all citizens to join in the celebration of that day.
