



### NEIGHBORHOOD TREE PROGRAM: REQUEST A FREE STREET TREE

Since 2000, the Falls Church Village Preservation and Improvement Society (VPIS) and the City of Falls Church have worked in partnership with City residents through the Neighborhood Tree Program to increase the City's tree canopy coverage and expand the number of shade trees along streets throughout the community.

Applications received by March 1 will be considered for spring tree planting (by end of May). Applications received by September 1 will be considered for fall tree planting (by end of October).
